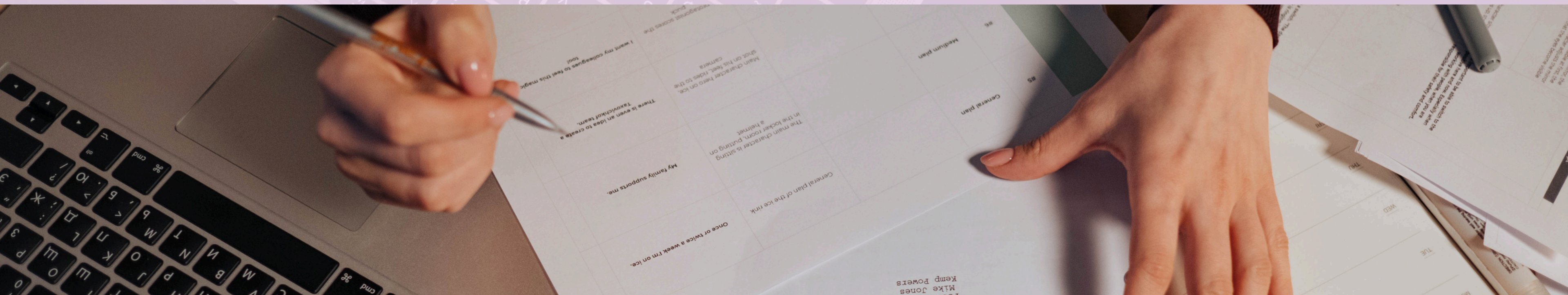

Recently, we launched the Transnational Law Department, where professors from Europe and the United States teach in English. This allows our students to benefit from international expertise and prepares them for the global legal landscape.

We have also developed several double degree programs with universities in Poland, Italy, India, and the Commonwealth of Independent States (CIR), including Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, and Russia. These programs offer students the chance to study abroad and earn degrees from both TSUL and our partner universities. The programs cover not only general legal education but also specialized fields such as cyber law and natural resources law, critical areas for future legal professionals in today's interconnected world.

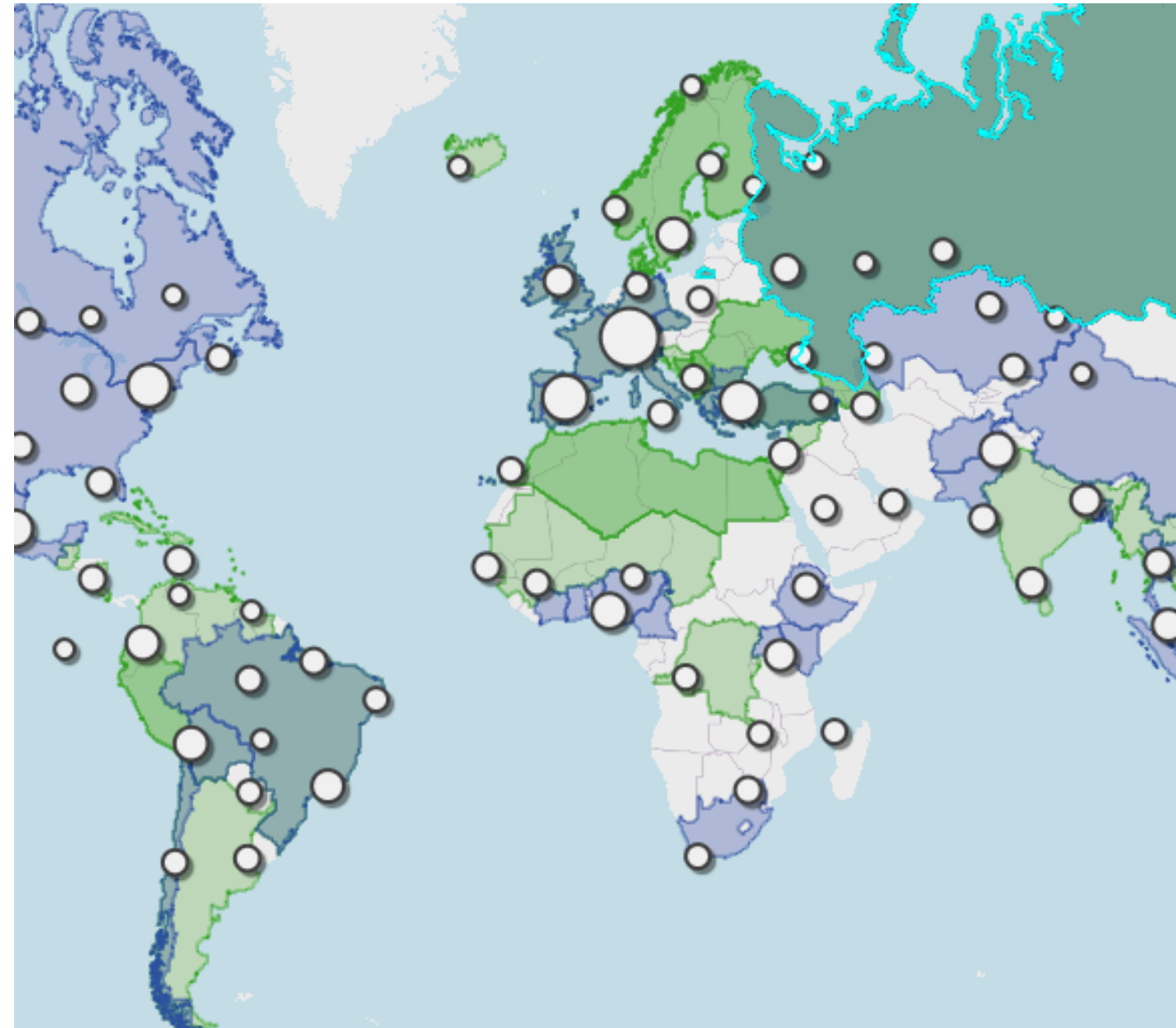

TSUL became the first university in Uzbekistan to join "The Hanseatic League of Universities" (HLU), a prestigious international association founded by the Hanseatic University of Applied Sciences



Through the HLU's World's Universities with Real Impact (WURI) rankings, TSUL evaluated global research and innovation projects, focusing on their societal impact, which aligns with the goals of sustainable development. These efforts helped TSUL enhance its contribution to SDG-related initiatives by learning from and contributing to global best practices in sustainability and education

The Tashkent State University of Law has won in the competition for the project "an innovative form of expanding the availability of legal education through the platform" Electronic University "funding in the amount of 140 thousand US dollars and carried out the following activities:

- ✓ 1. On March 6, 2019, the Ministry of Higher and Secondary Specialized Education of the Republic of Uzbekistan and the Tashkent State University of Law signed a contract AiF 2/23 in the amount of 140 thousand US dollars.
- ✓ 2. The first concept of the project was developed by the working group for the implementation of the project.
- ✓ 3. Based on the approved work schedule of 5 leading universities in Uzbekistan (Tuit, University of Turin, University of Westminster, Inha University, University of Singapore), 3-4 day visits were carried out in May 2019 to familiarize themselves with existing e-learning programs and study the accumulated experience.
- ✓ 4. According to the decision of the tender committee that the services are cheap, high-quality and guaranteed, Uzinfocom was deemed competent to conclude an agreement with United Integrator LLC for the creation and maintenance of state information systems for a total amount of 178,922,265 soums (one hundred seventy-eight million nine hundred twenty two thousand two hundred sixty-five rubles).

The team of TSUL ranked 7th among Asian countries at the Asia Cup International Law Moot Court Competition



For the first time, our team made it into the top 16 teams out of 100 participating teams from Asian countries and was invited to the oral rounds of the international competition. The team representing Tashkent State University of Law at the international competition consisted of Javokhir Miraliyev, Dildorabegim Kholikova, and Gulnoza Kosimova, under the guidance of TSUL teachers Azizbek Toirov and Shukhrat Rakhmonov.
