Does your university as a body systematically measure/track women's application rate and acceptance or entry rate?

Tashkent State Law University has introduced more than 12 types of scholarships and grants to support gender equality and female students. Among them, a scholarship named after Academician Khadicha Sulaimanova was introduced, and 10 girls have been awarded it so far.
